

Fill us with confidence in Your care.



### 2020 Croatian Festival *Update*



As you know, the festival committee made the difficult decision to cancel the 2020 Croatian Festival. We wanted to protect the health and safety of our volunteers and festival-goers in light of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Still, St. John the Baptist will need your help. Last year's festival raised more than \$60,000 - a substantial portion of the funds that support our church and its Catholic liturgy activities.

We ask that you contribute to St. John's the money you would typically spend at our festival. Instead of buying prizes, playing at the booths and buying food and drink, please give the church a donation in that amount.

In the next two weeks, you will receive the annual parish mailing with some familiar forms.

We will offer the traditional money raffle tickets (\$1 each or \$10 per page), and the Mini and Maxi 50/50 Raffles.

However, instead of the festival sponsorship, you will see the form "Support St. John's."

All of us are disappointed as we forego this year's festival. This is a century-long tradition at our church. We look forward to gathering again the Croatian way.
