# Our Parish Family

Our deep sympathies and prayers are with the family of Milka Krznaric. She died last year on April 3, 2020, at age 88.

The family postponed Milka's services during the pandemic and will now remember her with a funeral Mass at 10 a.m. Saturday, May 8, at our church.

She was born on Nov. 25, 1931, in Zaluka, Croatia, to Mijo and Sofija Mravunac.

Milka married Josip Krznaric and they left their homeland in 1957. Their travels in Communist Yugoslavia were difficult and they stayed in refugee camps. They finally arrived in Paris and worked in factories to save for their immigration to the U.S. They arrived in 1961 with one suitcase and the clothes they wore.

She worked at Echlin Inc. (Midland Brakes) for 35 years before her retirement in 1996. Milka belonged to St. John the Baptist Church, the Croatian-American Social Club and the Croatian Fraternal Union.

Survivors include her daughters Joanne Pyle and Jeannie (Paul) McCluskey; grandchildren Nick, Cameron and Lauren Gay, and Erin and Katie McCluskey and two great-grandchildren Trenton and Carson Gay. Her parents, husband and brothers preceded her in death.
