Call to Share

The Archbishop's annual Call to Share program is now completed. Our parish exceeded its target of \$18,176 with donations of \$20,020.

That is 110 percent of the goal - the highest percentage in Wyandotte County.

Only 74 families out of 198 contributed to Call to Share - about 37 percent of parishioners. The average gift was \$271.

Other parishes in our area that met the target were Holy Family, St. Mary-St. Anthony and St. Patrick.

workforce with the Internal Revenue Service.

Bob is survived by his daughters, Mary Kathleen Sullivan and Julianne Marie Sullivan. He is preceded in death by his wife, Ann J. Cindrich, who died in 2013; his parents and a sister, Bonnie.

Did you know? Croatians gathered on May 26, 1900, to discuss building a church and forming a committee to lead the process. A month later, the committee reviewed potential real estate: 4th and Barnett, \$1800; 5th and Ferry/Fowler, \$3,000. A day later, the group purchased the property at the current church location for \$1,650, with most of the \$100 deposit loaned by a committee member.
