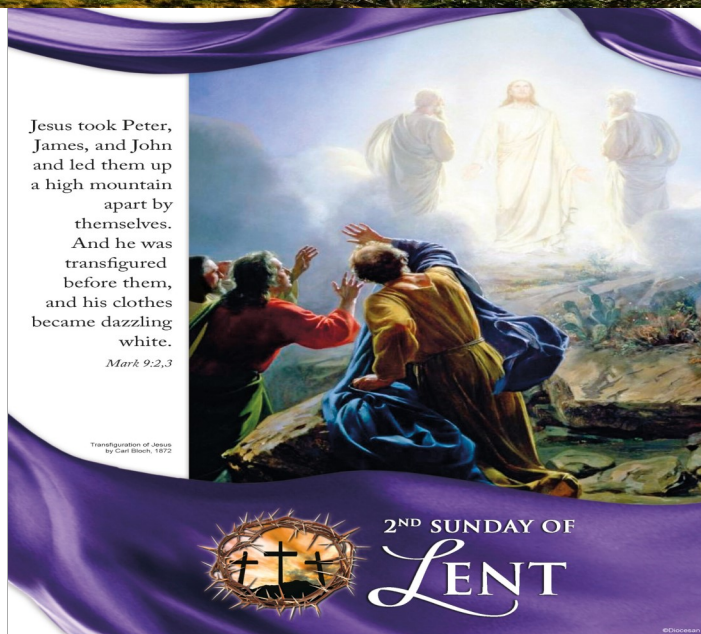

At the beginning of this past week, I had to travel to a Monastery where I was the extraordinary confessor to hear confessions of the monks. I returned home on Wednesday night just in time for the "storm." On Sunday afternoon, I will fly down to Florida for a Canon Law workshop. 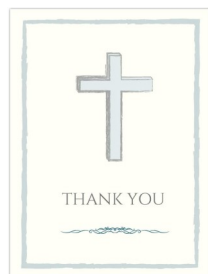

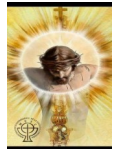
