

The month of June is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. St. Gertrude experienced the exquisite and divine beatings of Jesus' heart and wondered why St. John, who had also reclined on the Heart of Jesus at the Last Supper, had never written of his experience. St. John appeared to her in a vision and replied, "Yes, I heard them, and my soul was penetrated with their sweetness even to its very center...My mission was to write of the Eternal Word . . . but the language of the blissful pulsations of the Sacred Heart is reserved for latter times, that the time-worn world, grown cold in the love of God, may be warmed up by hearing of such mysteries." In 1856, Pope Pius IX established the Feast of the Sacred Heart as obligatory for the whole Church, to be celebrated on the Friday after Corpus Christi. This year, the solemnity will be on Friday 6/24/2022.
