## Keeping In Touch



This past Friday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This devotion has its origins in the eleventh century when Christians meditated on the five wounds of Christ. It was only in 1670 that the first feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated. Around the same time, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque began to have visions of Jesus. In 1673, during one of these apparitions, Jesus allowed the Saint to rest her head upon His Heart. During this moment, she experienced the comfort of His Presence. Jesus in this moment, told her of His great love and that He had chosen her to make his love and his goodness known to all. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has spread from that moment until today. This is a great devotion because in it we are invited to come and touch with God's great love for us. Whenever you see an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, think of God's great love for you and allow that love to transform your life.
