Offering in Reparation to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus (approved by Pope Pius VII on September 22, 1817, and enriched with an indulgence)

An Offering of the Precious Blood for Souls The Seven Offerings of the Precious

Blood (approved by Pope Pius VII and enriched with indulgences originating back to 1817)


