

For Catholics, the month of August is especially dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Just as the Sacred Heart is an image of Christ's love for mankind, the Immaculate Heart displays the Blessed Virgin's desire to draw everyone closer to her Son's Heart. The two feasts clearly belong together! Mary was the first disciple of Christ. Her Immaculate Heart was the first follower of His Sacred Heart, and it is through her Immaculate Heart that we may more fully embrace Christ. Over the course of history, various saints brought this truth to the attention of the wider Church. In the 17th century, St. John Eudes and his followers were some of the first devotees of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Years later, in 1799, Pius VI, while in captivity, granted a Bishop in Sicily a special feast of the Most Pure Heart of Mary for some of the churches in his diocese. Nearly 200 years later, in 1942, Pope Pius XII consecrated the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on the 15th anniversary of Fatima. Two years later, he extended the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary to the universal Church.
