

Memorial

Born in Pietrelcina in Campania (Italy), he joined the Capuchin community at Morcone. Ordained in 1910, he moved six years later to San Giovanni Rotondo in the Gargano peninsula. Bearing the wounds of Christ's Passion on his body (known as stigmata), he became famous for his ministry in the confessional, his spiritual direction and miracles. In 1956 he opened the 'Home to Relieve Suffering' near his friary. He was canonised in 2002. He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much.
