Doesn't the new sidewalk and curbing in front of the church look great?

The work soon will be complete from the top of Barnett to 4th Street. The two old trees on the Fourth Street side of the campus also have been taken down. The projects are two of several targeted by our Building and Grounds Committee. Next up is the replacement of the rectory roof and gutters. The approximate costs are \$76,486 for the sidewalk, \$18,500 for the roof and gutters and \$3,000 for the tree removal. Thank you parishioners for your continued support. Other projects on the horizon are replacing the rectory windows, improving the church basement, fixing the church's HVAC system, resealing the exterior of the church, installing handicap accessibility to the auditorium as well as painting the auditorium ceiling and addressing usage for the school building.
