
Ivan Zeleznak

Keeping In Touch

This past Friday, we celebrated the Feast of St. Blaise. As you may remember, it is on the Feast of St. Blaise that we bless throats. You may wonder why

we do this. St. Blaise is a martyr of the early church. He was a Medical Doctor and a Bishop. He was renowned for his healing. In 316, Bishop Blaise was arrested for being a Christian. On his way to the jail, a woman set her only son who was choking to death on a fishbone, at his feet. Blaise cured the child and though his captors were amazed, they could not get Blaise to renounce the faith. They then beat Blaise with a stick, tore at his flesh with iron combs, and finally beheaded him. This is the reason that we seek his intercession in blessing throats. The prayer that is prayed as we bless throats is as follows, "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and every other illness. In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

After the masses this weekend, I will be available to bless the throats of anyone who wishes.




