# The symbols of the PASCHAL CANDLE

The **Cross** symbolizes Christ.

The A (alpha) and  $\Omega$  (omega) symbolize God is the beginning & the end.

The current year 2023 symbolizes God present here today.

5 GRAINS OF INCENSE are placed in the candle to symbolize the 5 wounds of Christ (represented here by the 5 gold designs on the candle).

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb.

So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. The other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.
