

## Keeping In Touch

It should come as no great surprise that in the church there are many traditions that have been passed down over the years. Some of these traditions are very well known to us. Other traditions are perhaps less well known to us.

One of the traditions that is probably unknown to most of you, if not all of you who will read this, deals with the Sacred Oils (oil of the sick, oil of catechumens, sacred chrism) that the bishop blesses and consecrates each year. As these oils are blessed and consecrated each year, the oils that have been blessed and consecrated the previous year, which have not been used must be disposed of. Because they are blessed and consecrated, disposing of them must be done in a particular way. There are a couple of options for doing this, however, there is one option (tradition) that I prefer to perform each year is that of pouring the sacred oils over the graves of priests.

This past week while visiting the cemetery, I had the opportunity to perform this tradition. In the past, I have always poured the oil over the graves of the Augustinian Recollect priests. This year I also poured oil over the graves of Monsignor Mejak and Fr. Horvat. These two priests faithfully served our parishes and I thought it only appropriate that some

of the oils from our parishes should be placed on their graves. With great gratitude for their priestly ministry, let us pray for their eternal rest.

This year the club is able to offer three scholarships. One for elementary/ middle school, one for high school, and one for college/university. Each will be worth \$2,000. In order to qualify for the elementary/middle school and high school scholarships the applicant must be attending a Kansas City metro area Catholic school in the coming school year and be sponsored by a member of the club. In order to qualify for the college/university scholarship the applicant must have graduated from a Catholic high school and be sponsored by a member of the club or be a member themselves. The deadline for applying is *July 21st, 2023*.

If awarded the scholarship the recipient will not be eligible to receive the same education level scholarship again but will be eligible to apply for the other education level scholarships (eg. If applicant A receives the 2023-2024 high school scholarship they are no longer eligible for future high school scholarships, but will be eligible for the college/university scholarship).
