# Keeping In Touch

I write this to you as I am getting ready to head home from LaCrosse, WI. The canon law meetings have been wonderful and it has been great seeing fellow canonists and civil lawyers that I have not seen since last year. It has also been wonderful to meet some new ones. With learning and fellowship for this year's conference complete, we are all heading home and already look forward to next year. As I was considering what to write about this week, I thought of some of the experiences that I had when travelling to Canada this year. I thought it might be interesting for you to get a glimpse into what can happen when you travel as a priest these days. The first thing that happened was that I had a long layover in an airport and decided to get a smoothie. As I was in the lineup a couple of us entered into a conversation which started about delays and travelling in bad weather and in the midst of this conversation one person said that they were taking this as a sign that they had to get to confession. They had been feeling like they needed to but had been putting it off. I said that we could take care of that right now. We found a quite spot in across from the smoothie store and I heard their confession. The next experience was a little different. When I arrived at the Canadian boarder I went through the expedited line as I have NEXUS. Usually this is a very quick process. When I presented my printout to the Custom Agent he began asking questions and the same questions over and over again. At one point he asked if I had any electronics with me. I responded that I did. He continued asking the same questions he had asked before. Finally, he gave me my paper so that I could get my luggage. I knew, however, that this was not the end. Sure enough I was pulled aside for further inspection. You may wonder why .... Because I was priest is the answer and he thought that he might catch me with something on my electronics. The Agent that did the inspection was nicer and of course everything was fine. Travelling as a priest today you

never know what you will encounter and often you find yourself going from ministry encounters to great suspicion!




