Keeping In Touch

It is hard to believe that this coming week we will enter the month of November. We always begin the month of November by recalling all of our faithful departed and in fact during the whole month we are invited to pray for our beloved dead. This is an ancient practice of the church. St. Monica, who died in the year 387 AD, is quoted as having said before her death to her son, St. Augustine, "all I ask is that you remember me at the altar of God."

While we remember the souls of those who have gone before us in a special way this month, it reminds us of the importance of praying for the dead all the time. As is our tradition we will be praying for our beloved dead, in a particular way for those who have passed during the past year. There will be a Book of the Dead with the names of those who have passed during the year and we invite you to add the names of those who have gone before us who you wish to remember. Next to our Book of the Dead, there will be a purple candle that will burn for the entire month. The continual burning of the candle symbolizes our prayer which is offered in faith entering into the presence of God. As we call to mind all those who we have loved which have gone before us, let us pray that they will truly be at rest in the presence of our God. Eternal rest grant

unto them O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their soul and all the souls of the faithful departed, rest in peace. Amen.
