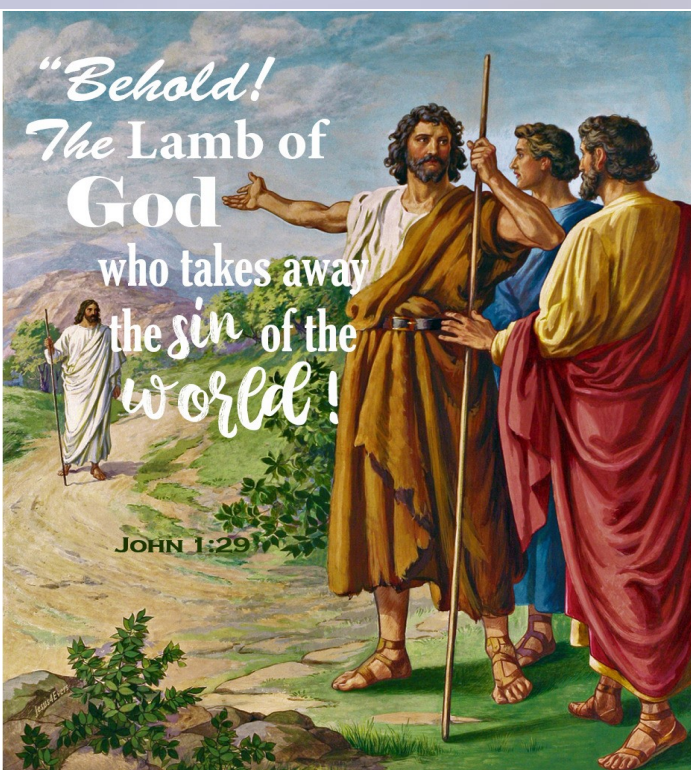

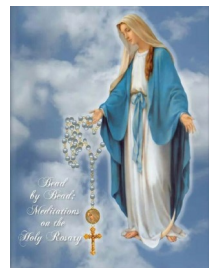
125th Anniversary Books have arrived!!

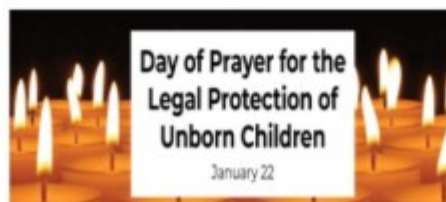
